

- 8. RECEIVER AND RECEIVER BATTERY SHOULD BE PACKED IN FOAM RUBBER (THE TYPE THAT IS SOLD FOR THAT PURPOSE).
- 9. BATTERY, RECEIVER, FUEL TANK MUST BE INSTALLED IN SUCH A WAY AS TO PREVENT IT FROM MOVING DURING FLIGHT.
- 10. USING THE TEST BOX AT THE FIELD AND FOLOWING FREQUENCY PROCEDURES, RANGE CHECK YOUR AIRPLANE.

FLYING

- 1. IF YOU HAVE NOT FLOWN A REMOTE CONTROL AIRPLANE BEFORE, DO NOT START NOW. HAVE ONE OF THE CLUB FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS OR EXPERIENCED FLYERS CHECK OUT YOUR PLANE AND FLY ITS MAIDEN FLIGHT.
- 2. PRIOR TO FLYING YOUR PLANE YOU MUST HAVE A BASIC KNOWLEDGE OF WHAT STICK DOES WHAT. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO FLY THE AIRCRAFT YOURSELF, THE ODDS ARE A MILLION TO ONE AGAINST YOU.
- 3. DON'T HESITATE TO ASK QUESTIONS DURING THE BUILDING STAGE, IT IS EASIER TO CORRECT MISTAKES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION THAN IT IS AFTER CONSTRUCTION.
