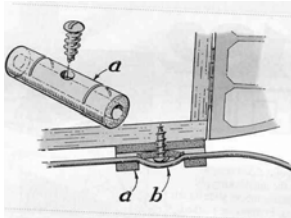

Tip of the Month

Antenna Tensioner

Make a couple of cross slits in an inch or of fuel line (a), screw it to the top of the fin or bottom of the fuselage, then thread the antenna wire (b) through it as shown. It will keep the antenna wire tight yet will allow it to slip if it is snagged.

January 17, 2006 Minutes

The January 17, 2006 meeting of the RC Propbusters was called to order at 8:00 PM with 13 members present. The minutes of the December meeting were read by Bernie Liskov and accepted as written. There was no treasurers' report as Bernie forgot to bring it in.

Ron will read the annual report of financial standing at the February meeting. There were no communications or bills turned in. Under old business, Bernie reported back with his findings about getting more formal nameplates for the officers and the instructors. He showed a black writing on yellow laminated background with a broach clip and a thick white credit card style nameplate also with a broach clip back. After a discussion, a motion was made to buy the yellow laminated name badges and the motion passed. Bernie showed a newer design regular member badge and the laminated pouches they would go into. A motion was made and passed to authorize the purchase of a rectangular hole punch and the necessary materials to implement the new cards.

Also under old business, Andy Argenio who is the AMA district 1 VP spoke with me about having an AMA event at our field this year. He told me that there was a 100% certainty that Gardner MA will have an event and that Woodstock is a 90% certainty. He explained that we and he would have to decide if our event would be an open event or a more specialized event such as a warbird of giant scale meet. He will visit our field the Monday after next with Jack Holmgren to access our facility and parking situation. He gave some available dates and we voted on 3 dates in descending order of interest. They are Oct 6-8, Sept 29-Oct 1, and Sept 22-24. We will discuss this more during the February meeting.

Under new business, the dates of proposed events for this year were discussed and voted on. Those dates were Bob Beringer Memorial Scale fly-in on June 10-11 with Fred Meyer as the CD. Next would be the Henry Struck Memorial Electric Fly-in on July 22-23 with George Cintron as CD. The neighborhood Fun Fly-In is on August 13 with Ray knierem and Dennis Duplice making the arrangements. The club Fly-In is on August 26 with John Banks at the controls. And last is the Heli Fly-In on Sept. 9-10 with Eric Ehrenfels as the CD.

Rudy suggested that each event would have an explanation of what it is about. Dennis asked for introductory pilots for the neighborhood fun fly and Tom Vernon, Dennis Duplice, Bernie Liskov, Fred Meyer, Jack Holmgren, George Cintron, John Banks, and Bob Boudreau volunteered.

New Business

Dennis pointed out that the bylaws are posted on the website and asked that Rich update them to reflect the meeting times and day. Dennis also asked that more people in the club become Contest Directors to help share the load. Jack asked about looking into Baseball style warm up jackets for the members to purchase. He and George will look into it.

Good and Welfare

Rich LaSaracina suggested we have committees to help out during the events. Bernie, John Banks, Fred Meyer, and Jack Holmgren will be the organizing committee for the Proposed AMA event. We hope to get more people to volunteer at the next months meeting. George Cintron said that he will arrange his own help.

Dennis is also looking for more volunteers to help in mowing the field. Those that are already on board are Dennis, Jack, Bill Trantalis, Rich Whittle and they need more to share the workload.

There were no new members and no model of the month. The meeting was adjourned at 8:07 PM.
