WATER BASED NON-TOXIC CLEANER

When rebuilding engines, you need a good metal cleaner that will remove baked on oil and carbon. Here is a formula for a water-based non-toxic cleaner for all metal parts.

60 ml liquid fabric cleaner
60 ml Sunlight dishwashing liquid
240 ml tap water.

You now have a safe water-based metal cleaner.
