How your membership card will be used this year

Cut a slot on the short side and install the clip provided. Use CA to fix the metal clip to the plastic strap.

Glue a clothes pin or clip to the back of the membership card. This is the easiest solution.

Please remember to use your new card as your frequency pin. All of the frequencies you use are printed on the card so make sure you locate it correctly.

7. Issues that must be followed.
 - a. You must have an observer with you to watch out for boats and fisherman.
 - b. To reduce the risk of a collision, the flying pattern must be followed.
 - c. You may not buzz the beach area to reduce the risk of a crash in the parking area or spectator area.
