TIP OF THE MONTH CUT TUBING WITHOUT BURRS

Tubing cutters do a great job but always squeeze the tube & leave a burr on the inside. Insert an appropriate sized piece of music wire into the tube as a shim & put a little lubricant on it to help with the removal after cutting. Bo reaming after cutter is required & problems with burrs or crushed tubing is eliminated.
