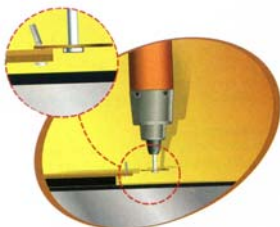

### TIP OF THE MONTH

Shortening screws & bolts

Tape pieces of ply together to get the correct thickness & use the surface of the ply wood as a guide for your cutoff wheel. This also works with bench grinders, diagonal cutters, & other similar tools, all the parts can be cut prior to wearing out the jig too much. The plywood holds the part securely, & you will not burn your fingers.
